

# CSR TEAM CONDUCTS BARANGAY PROFILING IN DMRA

With our continuing commitment to providing better services to our host community under the HERO (Health, Education, Rural Infrastructure and Opportunities to Earn) program, the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Team of the Philippine Mining Development Corporation conducted a barangay profiling last January 14-19, 2018 in the four barangays of the Diwalwal Mineral Reservation Area (DMRA), Monkayo, Compostela Valley Province, namely: Upper Ulip, Mt. Diwata, Naboc and Tubo-Tubo.

Aside from gathering the demographic profile of each barangay, the team also collected data on available/existing infrastructure and service institutions of the four barangays, school profile, Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Preparedness Plan as well as the list of programs, projects, and activities based on the barangay's Annual Investment Program.

The data gathered during the barangay profiling will serve as inputs to further improve PMDC's CSR projects and for management to ensure that these interventions will address the current needs, requirements, issues and concerns of the people in DMRA.

After conducting the barangay scoping in the four barangays in DMRA, the team together with the PMDC's Business Development Department also spearheaded the census taking of the households in Tagbanao Area, Sitio Depot, Barangay Upper Ulip in preparation for the development of the Diwalwal Special Economic Zone last January 23-24, 2018.

The survey was purposely initiated to determine the residents' educational attainment, present occupation, source of income, and years of residency in Sitio Depot. The two-day census covered a total of seventy-eight (78) households with a total individual population of 367. The data and other relevant information gathered by the team will also serve as basis and inputs especially to the Business Development Department in designing and implementing sustainable community development projects and livelihood programs, which are intended to help alleviate the present economic condition of the affected residents in the area.
